

RULES - Hastings Old Town Carnival - RULES

- MAXIMUM HEIGHT FROM GROUND 16th
- MAXIMUM WIDTH 8ft
- ALL OWNERS OF PARTICIPATING VEHICLES SHOULD CLEAR SUCH USE WITH THEIR OWN INSURERS &
 ENSURE THAT ALL VEHICLES ARE STREET LEGAL.
- 4. ENTRANTS ARE REQUIRED TO EFFECT THEIR OWN LIABILITY INSURANCES IN RESPECT OF ANY INJURY ARISING OR DAMAGE CAUSED TO THIRD PARTIES IN RELATION TO THE EVENT. THIS MAY NOT COVER PARTICIPANTS SO PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR OWN INSURERS OR OBTAIN A WAIVER (See Marshal's Guide Enclosed)
- Float Organisers must check the route prior to the procession.
- 6. EACH FLOAT MUST PROVIDE 2 WALKING MARSHALS ALONGSIDE THE FLOAT AT ALL TIMES
- No commercial advertising except Class 15 and no leaflets or flyers
- All collectors under the age of 14 to be accompanied by an adult
- A separate form must be used for each entry
- All Challenge Cups must be returned upon request or by June following Carnival
- The Committee reserves the right to re-classify or refuse any entry
- The Judges' decisions are final on all awards
- Collections for Old Town Carnival charities only
- 14. THE THROWING OF ANY ARTICLES OR SQUIRTING OF LIQUIDS FROM FLOATS OR BY PEDESTRIANS IS BANNED. FLOATS WILL BE INSPECTED AND WITHDRAWN FROM THE PROCESSION IF THIS RULE IS NOT STRICTLY COMPLIED WITH
